• Accounts Update

The position of the PSA Bank account is as follows:

• Playground Plans

Mrs MacDonald & Mrs Chalmers have both been discussing the playground plans with Mr Campbell (Planning) & Mr Wylie (HSE), they will require to review and approve any proposals before build work commences.

Two areas have been identified within the playground to Bark, it was discussed that a border would need to be built and ongoing maintenance of the areas would need to be organised by the school or PSA members.

Sarah had ordered and now taken delivery of the scooter boards and the school now requires tyres to build a race type circuit in both playgrounds.

Action: Sharon & Vicky to confirm if they still have the contacts for tyres and what transport is required to uplift.

An area was identified by Mrs MacDonald for the painted mural boards and a quiet corner for the children. A proposal to be pulled together for the relevant bodies to sign off before build.

Action: Joiner (Gavin McDonald) to be asked if he can provide board fixing instructions to comply with British Standards.

Action: A response from Shotts Prison in regards to the benches and storages units and compliance with British Standards is still outstanding.

Mrs Chalmers ran through the playground “wish list” that the children themselves presented:

It was agreed that the first 5 could be purchased by the PSA and put into use quickly.
